Key takeaway

In 2021, No religion was the most common religious affiliation among residents in Unincorp. Other Territories, accounting for 35.1% (872 people). This share was higher than Other Territories (27.1%). Since 2016, the biggest change was in Buddhism, which decreased by 338 people and 7.4 percentage points.

About this topic

Religion records a person's stated religious affiliation, including no religion and not stated responses. It is a measure of cultural identity and belief rather than practice or participation.

This topic helps show the religious diversity of an area and can support planning for community facilities, faith-based services, and inclusive engagement. It is best interpreted with ancestry, birthplace, and language, which together provide a broader picture of cultural composition.

Interpretation notes

- This records stated religious affiliation, not attendance or level of religious practice.
- No religion and not stated are part of the overall picture, so interpretation should consider both affiliation and non-response.
